Fees:

Fees for the winter season are as follows:

Seniors	\$145.00 per player
Juniors	\$115.00 per player
Sub Juniors	\$105.00 per player
Netta	\$ 90.00 per player

All fees to be paid in full at registration.

We must do this as in previous years we have had too much money outstanding for too long.

The Club cannot afford to pay all players fees up front and then not recoup this.

Players who have not paid in full cannot and will not take the court. This is for Insurance reasons as well.

Uniforms:

All players registered with GNC are to be wearing the correct uniform. The club will make every effort to ensure that all players are wearing the proper outfit by the first playing date.

Costs:

Sub Juniors, Juniors and Seniors
Skirts: \$12 .00 to hire for the season
\$10 .00 bond only if you are new to GNC
Tops: \$30.00 for new tops (approx. – waiting on our supplier)
\$15.00 for second hand.

If you need a new top, please bring along your old one for us to on sell. This helps to keep costs down for all players.

Netta – Skirt is provided. Tops are to be supplied by players.

As usual, we have kept the fees increase to a minimum and will continue to fundraise for our Equipment (uniforms, balls, skipping ropes, medical kits etc etc) and Presentation and Trophy night. If we do not get help we will look at a levy system of approx \$40.00 per player to cover the costs.



We would like to avoid this, as fundraising is a more "Community" thing – something that Greenmount Netball Club wants to encourage. If you can help in any way at all, please contact a committee member. We all had a great time last year at the Rollerskating night and then the end of year Disco.
